Tanker/Vehicle Accident		Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. Call the emergency services: Dial 111 Weer DVC everytile chemical equipment for excepted and service							
Spill or leak		Wear PVC overalls, chemical resistant gloves, facemask or goggles. Prevent further spillage. Collect spilled material and place in sealable container for disposal. Wash down affected area with water plus detergent. Absorb and collect washings and place in the same sealable container for disposal. Seek advice from the local authority regarding disposal.							
Fire		Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. Wear PVC protective clothing and breathing apparatus. Extinguish fires with water spray, fog or foam. During a fire toxic fumes may be released. Cool containers with flooding quantities of water until well after fire is out. Contain run-off. Keep non-involved persons away.

If swallowed		Rinse mouth with water. DO NOT induce vomiting. If any discomfort persists, seek medical advice. For advice, contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764 766) or a doctor immediately.							
If in eyes		Hold eyelids apart and flush the eye continuously with running water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention if irritation persists.							
If on skin		If skin or hair contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and wash skin and hair with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation occurs and persists.
