Hazard	Response
<b>Tanker/Vehicle Accident</b>	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. <b>Call the emergency services: Dial 111</b>
<b>Spill or leak</b>	Prevent migration into the environment - onto adjacent land or into waterways. Lightly mist unrecoverable product with water and sweep or scrape up. Wear protective equipment including eye protection to avoid exposure. Large spills due to traffic accidents, etc., should be reported immediately to NZTA for assistance.
<b>Fire</b>	<b>Call the Fire Service: Dial 111.</b> May emit toxic fumes when exposed to heat.

**First Aid**

<b>If swallowed</b>	If product is swallowed, do NOT induce vomiting. Contact a Poisons Information Centre / doctor immediately.
<b>If in eyes</b>	If splashed in eyes, hold eyelids open and flush with a steady, gentle stream of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention immediately.
<b>If on skin</b>	If skin or hair contact occurs thoroughly wash affected areas with soap and water.
<b>If inhaled</b>	Remove patient to fresh air. Get medical attention if breathing difficulty develops.

**Storage and segregation summary**

<b>Storage</b>	Store in original container in a cool, dry, ventilated place away from direct heat or direct sunlight. Store away from foodstuffs, animal feed, children and animals. Keep container sealed when not in use.
